Wombats

Most people know that koalas and kangaroos are native animals in Australia. However, fewer people hear of wombats—the animal heroes in bushfire since November 2019. Let’s learn something about wombats, also the native animals in Australia.


Facts about wombats:

Appearance
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● A wombat has four short but powerful legs. ● Wombats are full of muscles though they look fat. ● Wombats have short tails. ● Like female kangaroos or koalas, a wombat mom has a pouch. However, a wombat pouch is between its back legs and opens toward the ground. ● Wombats have strong claws, and they are excellent diggers.
Size
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Length: About 75 cm to 1m long. ● Weight: 19~40 kgs.
Diet
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Wombats can eat only one meal in 14 days. ● They eat grasses and roots only. ● They seldom drink water because they can get moisture from plants.
Other interesting facts:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The short but powerful legs of wombats can run up to 40 kilometers per hour when needed. ● Wombats are good at digging holes and tunnels. The holes and tunnels they dug form their underground homes and are called <u>burrows</u>. ● One wombat usually has several underground homes, and each is connected with tunnels. ● A wombat doesn’t share his or her burrow with another one but allow to use in different time. ● Wombats enjoy living alone except when female wombats need to take care of their kids. ● The temperature in burrows doesn’t change very often. Wombats can keep warm in winter and keep from the heat in summer in their burrows.


Some people said wombats herd other animals to hide in the burrows during the bushfire. Actually, wombats didn’t call and invite other animals to use their homes. Wombats just “allow” them to use. Whatever way wombats use, they truly help other animals. Remember get a chance to visit wombats at the zoo when you are in Australia.


