Sir Nicholas Winton

Mrs. Winton found his husband's scrapbooks at the attic. The scrapbooks inside with names, pictures, letters from family and many papers. She asked her husband for what happened. But Mr. Winton said he thought the papers had no value. That moment, she knew her husband was a Hero. His work was not noticed by the world for 50 years. She explored it and Mr. Nicholas Winton was invited to the BBC television program “That's Life!”, where he was reunited with several of the 669 children he had saved.

Back to the time before Christmas 1938, Mr. Winton, a 29-year-old stockbroker, was planning to travel to a skiing holiday. Then a call for help from friends. He raised more money to rescue children in Czech. Their parents were killed

even while many of Czech families sold all things to pay for their kids' escape. On the March 14, 1938, all came together at the station. The survivors said the final moment before departure, the children cried not to be sent away, and parents faced giving up their children.

Mr. Winton and his friends arranged for eighth more trains to get the children out of Czech and arrived in London, England. There, he and host families met the children. But still about 250 children on the last train couldn't be saved out. On Sept. 1, 1939, however, on that day, Hitler invaded and closed all borders. Winton's rescue efforts came to an end. None of the 250 children was ever seen again. All were believed to be sent to the concentration camps.

Many of 669 children went on works in different fields, and their descendants were over 6000 people. Many now in their 70s and 80s, still call themselves "Winton's children".

How did he do so hard work? Nicholas Winton's said his motto, "If something is not impossible, then there must be a way to do it." He was awarded many honours. He died in his sleep, in 2015, at the age of 106.
