

四、閱讀測驗 16%

(一) (綜合)

The people in Bergün, a village(村莊) near St Moritz in Switzerland, decided to ban(禁止) visitors to take pictures – but they want visitors to be happy, reports The Local(地方報).

“Our village is very beautiful, and lots of visitors took pictures of it. They uploaded them to the Facebook to let others admire the beauty of our village.” the locals(當地人) said.

“Scientists proved(科學家證實) that beautiful holiday pictures on social media(社群網站) like Facebook make(使) the viewers(觀看者) sad because they cannot be there in person,” the visitor office(觀光處) said.

“We sincerely(誠摯地) invite you to visit Bergün to admire(欣賞) the beauty of our village in person,” said the Mayor(村長), Peter Nicolay.

The village plans to fine(罰) the visitors breaking the rules €5(5 歐元). But some people think that they just want to promote(推廣) their village by doing this, and the visitor office also admitted(承認) that it is a small part of its plan.

On social media, some people think the ban is terrible, but some people don't. One man wrote: “It's so cool! It shows bravery(勇氣) and a sense of humor(幽默感)!” But another woman said, “This will stop people from visiting this place and make you look stupid(愚蠢的).”

(二) (綜合)

Want to become a better person? Then you may want to consider picking up a book because according to(根據) a new study(研究), reading regularly could make you kinder(更親切) and more empathic(更同理心).

Researchers (研究者) looked at the effects(影響) of reading and watching television on human behaviors(人類行為). They asked participants(受試者) questions about their preference(偏好) for books, TV and plays(戲劇). Then the researchers gave the participants interpersonal skills(人際技巧) test, such as(像是) how much they considered(考慮) people' s feelings(感覺) and whether(是否) they want to help other people.

The study found that readers were more(更) likely(可能) to show socially acceptable(社會接受的) behaviors. Instead(相反), TV lovers were less friendly(較不友善) and less(較不) understanding of others' feelings. “If you like reading, you will be more likely to see things from other people' s points of views(觀點) and understand other people better(更加).”

The study revealed(顯示) that fiction(虛構小說) readers showed more positive social(正向社會的) behavior while(然而) readers of drama(戲劇) and romance novels(浪漫小說) were the most(最) empathic. Similarly(同樣地), lovers of more experimental(科學實驗性) books showed the ability(能力) to see things from different views(觀點).

Children today spend half their parents' time before playing outside(外面), a study says.

The researchers of the National Trust interviewed 1,001 parents, and their children's age were between four and fourteen. 96% of the parents thought it is important for their children to have connection(連結) with nature(自然) because playing outside is good

for them to grow up(成長).

The research found children today play outside for only four hours a week on average(平均), but their parents spent 8.2 hours doing it before.

The Trust has a list(清單) of fifty things for children to do before the age of eleven. In three quarters(3/4) of the activities, children have to go outdoors(戶外), like climbing a tree, catching bugs(蟲), and tracking(追蹤) wild(野生) animals.

The National Trust hopes(希望) to teach our children to love our nature and protect(保護) the beauty of nature in the future.

Drivers will greet(歡迎) the passengers and make sure the route(路線) when(當) they get in the taxis. And then the drivers won't talk with the passengers anymore. But there are two exceptions:

1. Only if(如果) the passengers speak to the drivers first, the they are allowed(允許) to talk.

2.If there is something emergent(緊急的), the drivers can communicate(溝通) with the passengers.
