



Kate: When visiting a person's home in Taiwan, it is important to bring a gift. The gift can be fruit, chocolates, cake but not a clock or a knife. The word for "clock" sounds the same as "the end of life" in Chinese and "knife" means cutting off a relationship. By the way, don't be surprised that your friends put your gift down to open it later after receiving it. Taiwanese people think it's not polite to open a gift in front of the giver.

Mark: In America, we usually give gifts when visiting a friend's home for the first time. If you are confused what to give, a gift to represent your hometown would never go wrong. Food like chocolates, homemade cookies or a bottle of wine will do, too. However, don't give something too expensive or ask your friends what gift they would like. This will make your friend uncomfortable and feel they need to give a gift in return. By the way, don't feel shocked if your friend opens the gift right in front of you. It's common for Americans to do so.

Lucy: We give gifts in almost any occasion, such as weddings, business meetings, dinner parties or returning from a trip. Gift-giving is more like a "must-do" in Japanese culture. Japanese think the action of gift giving is more important than the gift itself. As for the gifts, anything will do except for a comb because "comb" sounds like "suffer" and "die" in our language.

The 7th month on Lunar Calendar is known as "Ghost Month" in Taiwan. On 7/1, the gate to the Underworld will open at 11 p.m. and all ghosts and spirits would come to the living world for one month. During this time, people honor their dead family members by preparing food, drinks and burning praying cash. On the 15th day of Ghost Month, all the temples in Taiwan will hold "Zhongyuan Pudu", giving meals and traditional music show to the wandering ghosts. It is also called "Hungry Ghost Festival". Besides temples, families and companies also make offerings to the wandering ghosts. Food of all kinds are placed on tables outside of the house in case the ghosts and spirits enter people's homes. By pleasing the ghosts, you don't have to worry that something unlucky would happen to you.

According to the tradition, there are things we can't do on Ghost Month like having weddings, planning a trip or even buying a new car. You should avoid singing at night because **it** could attract ghosts to your home. That is dangerous. Also, you had better not go swimming because you could be drown by ghosts in the water.

Although all the have-to-do or not-to-do for Ghost Month sounds funny. Just to play it safe, it will be better to follow the tradition-when in Rome, do as the Romans do.
