Recent research suggests that children's brains work differently when reading from paper compared to screens. A study from the Israel Institute of Technology looked at 15 children aged 6 to 8. The researchers used EEG technology to measure brain activity while the children read on paper and screens.


The results showed that reading on paper activated parts of the brain linked to focus and understanding. On the other hand, reading on screens caused more brain strain and made it harder for kids to stay focused. This extra mental effort could explain why children often remember less from screen reading.

Although the study only included a small group, it raises important questions. If these findings are correct, teachers and



parents might need to think about how much screen time is used for reading and learning.

What about you? Do you prefer reading from books or screens? Some people like books because they help them focus and feel more comfortable. Others like screens because they're convenient and can store many books in one device. Either way, it's important to choose what works best for you!

Insects have more eyes than humans, and some even have thousands of lenses in their eyes! For example, butterflies have four eyes, spiders have eight, and caterpillars have 12. Houseflies have about 4,000 lenses in each eye, while dragonflies have an incredible 30,000 lenses. However, having more eyes or lenses does not always mean better vision.

Insects have compound eyes. These eyes are made up of many tiny parts called lenses, and each lens looks in a different direction. This allows insects to see all around them, but their vision is not clear. Human eyes, on the other hand, focus on one thing at a time and see much more detail. In fact, human vision is about 100 times sharper than the best insect eye.

Most insects can only see light and dark, but some, like bees, can see colors that humans cannot. Even so, their vision is not as vivid or detailed as ours. While insects may have many eyes, humans can see better details and colors. This makes our eyes more effective for tasks that require clear and sharp vision.
