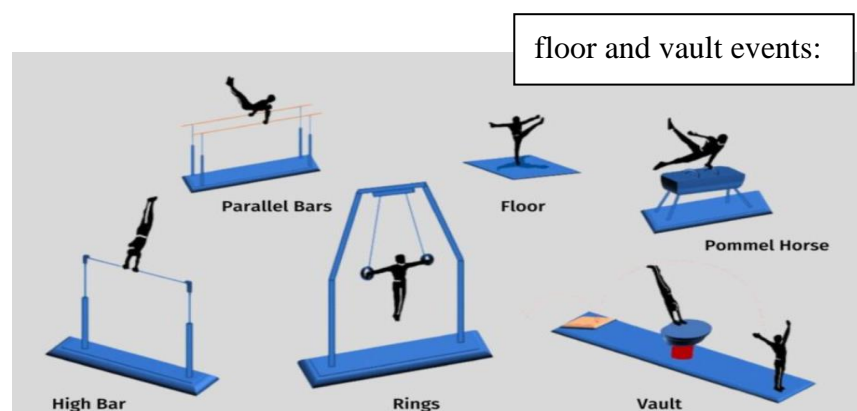

It says that eating a few grapes each day can help keep our eyes healthy. A researcher explained that grapes are beneficial for eye health. 34 adults took part in the study. Half of them ate grapes every day, while the other half ate a different snack that was not real grapes. The people did not know if they were eating grapes or the other snack. This helped the researchers get better results. The study showed that the people who ate grapes had stronger muscles around their retina. The retina is the part of the eye that

sends information about light to the brain. It also helps protect the eyes from blue light, which can harm the eyes. A lot of blue light comes from computer screens, so protecting our eyes is very important.

In Japan, new suitcases with motors that you can ride are causing some problems. These suitcases let travelers sit on them and go up to 13 kilometers per hour. They are becoming very popular, but they are also causing problems at airports, train stations, and on the streets of Tokyo. In Japan, these suitcases are treated like motor vehicles. This means you can only ride them on roads. Riders must wear a helmet, have a driver's license, and have insurance. The suitcases must be registered and need to have rear-view mirrors and indicator lights. Because of this, airports in Osaka and Nagoya are asking travelers to pull their suitcases instead of riding them.

These electric suitcases have been around since 2016. A company called Modobag made them and used the slogan "the carry-on that carries you." Recently, celebrities like Blackpink, Katy Perry, and Paris Hilton have shared videos online of themselves riding these suitcases. British Airways will allow these suitcases on planes only if the lithium batteries can be removed because they are a fire risk. Dr. Takeru Shibayama says new ways of transport will keep coming, and new laws will always be needed.

Every year on August 13, we celebrate International Left-Hander's Day. This special day is for left-handed people, who are fewer in number and often find things harder in a world because the world is mostly made for right-handed people.
