### **Ponzi Scheme**

A Ponzi scheme is a special kind of crime. It's a fake investment that one schemer (or a group of schemers) gets other people to give money to. In Ponzi schemes, the schemer often says, "I found a great way to make money fast. The more you give me, the more I can invest in that plan, and the more I can earn for us all." But Ponzi scheme doesn't "earn money". Instead, all too many investors, the system will always crash. This is because the investors all expect more money than they invested, and they will get impatient.

The scheme was named after a man, Charles Ponze. His first scheme used countries' money exchange rates to make money, mostly on international postage stamps. But money soon stopped being invested in coupons, and went to early investors, and a lot to Ponzi himself.

Ponzi schemes often use impressive words, in fact, they aren't very clear.

Examples are:

1. Hedge future trading. (taking a good risk.)
2. High-yield investment programs. (high interest.)
3. Makes money easily in other countries.

Schemers often depend on investors not knowing about economics. People are cheated by schemers who seem to have money getting skill.

All is the result of greed. Ponzi schemes can be run anywhere, even online and are being run even now.

Don't be fooled by the schemers because of your greed.

No matter you are shopping at a supermarket or at a clothing store, many of the prices \_\_\_42\_\_\_ you see usually have something in common. Prices are more likely to end in .99 more than any other pair of numbers. Why aren't prices just even numbers?

Many stores like to mark their prices to end in .99 for discounts, and customers almost never notice that \_\_\_43\_\_\_. Though no one really knows who or how the trick started, it has been around for at least a century. Ending a price in .99 is based on the theory: we read from left to right, so we usually only see the first number of the price. The price \_\_\_44\_\_\_ starts with a 4 appears to be a better deal than the one that starts with 5. That's why even though a product for \$4.99 may be just one cent cheaper, the trick always helps sell more.

\_\_\_45\_\_\_, the .99 alone allows people to believe that the item is on sale. Customers often think they

are getting a good deal when they buy something with a price ending in .99.

The trick doesn't only work for cents. In other studies about women's clothes, a dress 46 price is changed from \$34 to \$39 is sold more. However, changing it from \$34 to \$44 doesn't have much different results. This proves that the number 9 has a surprising effect on customers. Now that you know the secrets behind the prices, look at them wisely when you go shopping next time.
