Easter Island, called Rapa Nui by the local people, is a small island far away in the Pacific Ocean. This island is famous for its mysterious Moai statues. These big stone statues were made by the ancestors of the Rapa Nui people between the years 1400 and 1650.

There are about one thousand Moai statues dotting the island. Most of the Moai face inland, like a sign of watching over and protecting the people of the island. Some people believe that the Moai statues were built to honor their important ancestors or leaders. Every year, many tourists come to visit this island and are curious about these giant statues.

The Rapa Nui people call their home Rapa Nui, not Easter Island. There is a small post office on the island, which is known as the "loneliest post office in the world." Tourists can send postcards here, and the postcards and stamps often have pictures of the Moai statues on them.

When you visit Easter Island, it is very important to *respect* the local culture. Tourists are told not to touch or climb on the Moai statues because this can damage them and also make the islanders unhappy. The Rapa Nui people think the Moai statues are very important to their history and culture. Also, the Moai statues do not only have heads; they also have bodies, but most of them are buried under the ground.
